

## The Lunans & Selenites Pre-game - Day17/20

Under constant occupation for more than 500 years the moon, or Luna, is seen by many other inhabitants of the Sol system as a bit of a spent force. The population live within a mix of surface domes and subsurface city warrens, etched out by generation after generation of occupiers. A utilitarian approach to existence is prevalent, with the majority of individuals content to go to work each day, commonly in either the excavation or construction industries, before returning home for an evening of imbibing piped food supplies and cabled entertainment systems.

Helium-4 is abundant on Luna, and the majority of the non-spin drive fuel supplies are obtained from within the lunar crust. This fact, and the abundant mass drivers littering the surface, have allowed the world to remain neutral throughout the majority of the Sol system wars. Dull and Useful for the most part.

What is unusual is that there has during the last century has seen the movement of approximately 30% of the population into the extensive array of crystal caverns discovered 300 km below the lunar surface.
